

## Riverside Membership Categories for the 2021-2022 Season

### Competitive Member Categories

**Annual** – These may be junior swimmers (9-12 years), Age Group Swimmers (13-18 years) and Open/Senior Swimmers who actively seek to swim at sanctioned competitive swimming meets. Competitive Swimmers may only compete in swimming events against other registered members or FINA accredited and registered members. **Age of member is based on age as of the 1 October 2021.**

**Junior Dolphin** – This membership is for 5-8 year olds who are graduating from Learn to Swim school and wish to explore the social environment of a swimming club.

**Participation** – This membership category is for swimmers aged 9 years and over, designed to recruit new members to our clubs and to cater for Open Water Swimming Series members wishing to align with a club and test their skills in club pool competitions.

### How to register

Registrations need to be completed Online and can be done on the Swimming WA website using the instructions attached. Please note online registration cost will include a surcharge.

### Non – competitive member categories

**Parent membership** - If a Riverside member is under 18 years of age, it is compulsory for a parent/guardian to also be a registered as a 'Non-Swimmer Member'. This does not make you a member of your Club. **Parent membership is \$5.00** and does **not** allow you to swim at Swimming WA sanctioned events.

## Contact Details of Parent/s or Guardian


Swimming WA requires that a parent/s or guardian will also join the Association when they have a child under the age of 18 within the club. This membership enables the parent / guardian be covered by Swimming WA's insurance policy while timekeeping at sanctioned WA events. **Parent membership is \$5.00** and does **not** allow you to swim at Swimming WA sanctioned events. Parent contact information will also be stored poolside in a secure location for Riverside coaches in case of emergency.
